


Instructions for the FAULHABER Wildlocker Partridge Call "RFBHUHN"

This instrument is not thought to be used to lure partridges and shoot them while on the ground, "i", "e" reposing or running. This would be not at all sportsmanlike.

But sometimes it can happen that there is an overpopulation of cocks, meaning that sitting hens are disturbed or eggs are damaged. In this case, which occurs usually in autumn, the partridge call can be used, giving satisfactory results. The call to attract old partridges is marked A on the instrument. The approaching birds should be watched carefully to distinguish between cocks and hens. Before the shot, cocks can be identified by the rust-coloured spots on their wings.

If the hens can't be found in woody areas, use the call for young birds (marked J on the instrument) in the open. Birds will either be

attracted and can then be distinguished accordingly or they answer and the approximate direction for tracking them down can be found. This call is also an excellent device for attracting weasels, foxes, stray cats and dogs.

Use the call, like all lures, sparingly producing a



by breathing or whistling into the instrument. This call can be repeated a few times with intervals of a few minutes

- The FAULHABER calls cannot be disassembled. This ensures a constant pitch.
