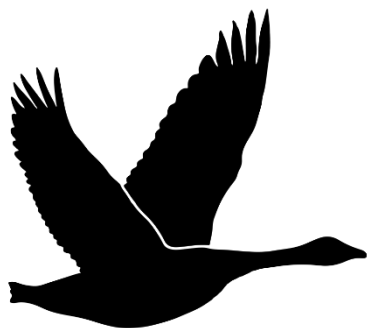




Instructions
for the
**FAULHABER Wildlocker
Goose Call**
"Gans"



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The FAULHABER Goose Call is designed to give two distinct and important sounds. The first is a lower pitch "guzzle", the second a higher pitch "honk". It is the quick control of the break between the two combined sounds that is most important, not allowing a slow sluggish slide from guzzle to honk, but instead a quick sharp break with the sound, resulting in a "her-onk". The break is controlled using the diaphragm in an outward puff from the belly, like a grunting sound. Care must be taken not to be sloppy at the end of the call. Don't release an extra puff of air at the end of the call to create a sound like "her-onk-ER". This extra third syllable turns a normal call into an alarm call, which will send the geese flying into the other direction.

Application:

The best time to call geese is in fog, when the geese cannot find their way, or when small groups are detached from the main skein. Calling at large skeins is only useful to attract attention to decoys, but sometimes a few calls will cause one bird at the end of the line to turn and fly over you.

In conjunction with decoys:

With proper placement and the right number of decoys, it is important to create the illusion that the decoys are conversing and

feeding. To do so, interchange the shout of the "honk" and the content feeding "guzzle" to complete the lure.

Flying geese expect to converse with birds on the ground and a silent group of geese would transgress the rules nature.

The FAULHABER Goose Call is specifically designed to imitate the cackle of geese with a good reach. Naturally, the guzzle and the honk from a distance sound much softer to the human ears than up close. Often hunters mistake the calls they hear from 30 or more yards to be soft purring when, up close, it is a hard cackle or chatter. Distance "outdoor" acoustics are as important to the imitation as the pitch of the call. Don't be afraid to use the instrument to its full benefit.

- The **FAULHABER** calls cannot be disassembled. This ensures a constant pitch.
