The magpie is one of the most dangerous nest-predators. A nest once discovered will attract it again and again till the entire brood is destroyed.

The magpie is a wary bird with keen eyes. Good cover is an absolute requirement for success. Before using the call, one should have already taken position in the woods where the magpies stay. They must have the possibility to approach under the protection of trees, as they dislike an approach through open areas and prefer to fly from tree to tree.

Using the call, one should take into account that the instrument should not be shaken in excess, thereby producing a long rattling sound, but content oneself with two or three shakes. Longer shakes will keep the magpies off as they will surmise danger.

To attract magpies from a long distance, the instrument is held upright on the top and bottom ends with thumb and index finger, shaking it twice or three times. The enclosed pieces will produce the desired sound. In order to attract nearby birds, the instrument is held on its casing. Birds in the immediate vicinity are lured with the instrument held in a bulge formed with the palm of hand.

Best results are attained at the end of summer, as whole families rove about. During the nesting season there might be some response, but birds will not approach.

- The **FAULHABER** calls cannot be disassembled. This ensures a constant pitch.
